

Parking on the Street?

Consider This...

While responding to an emergency, most fire department vehicles require a minimum of 14 feet of side-to-side clearance on a straight-away, and even more at intersections due to the large turning radius. For a large residential fire, the Ladder Truck is our best resource to save the house and prevent spread to neighboring homes. This truck requires 20 feet of side-to-side clearance in order to be set up and operated.

Please help us help our community by following a few simple rules: Not parking in a street when the driveway is available. Not parking at intersections if possible. Not parking perpendicular to the curb in a cul-de-sac.

Seconds matter in an emergency. If our emergency apparatus is delayed in responding, it could make the difference in saving a house or saving a life.
